### Resolution

**WHEREAS**, the State of New Jersey has adopted aggressive goals for the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions under the Global Warming Response Act; and

**WHEREAS**, many municipalities are developing action plans to address these areas at a local level; and

**WHEREAS**, the Environmental Commission has presented a plan to organize groups of interested citizens to identify energy, resource, and environmental conservation actions and promote the greening of Berkeley Heights; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council support and encourage this effort.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council will support and encourage the involvement of interested citizens, civic organizations, and businesses in this effort and will appoint a liaison from municipal government for the effort.

**IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall take effect pursuant to law.
